he Super Car+ Carnival is conceptualised on the basis of promoting a car culture in Hong Kong, according to Chacky Ip, a professional car racer and Chief Editor of 《CarPlus Magazine》. "Hong Kong has a very limited range of entertainment," he said. "So the Carnival has been organised to meet the fervent demands of car enthusiasts who have been clamoring for such activities for a long time. It is, at the same time, a colorful weekend outing for families."

The over-riding consideration in staging an event of such a magnitude and complexity is the availability of a suitable venue, and in space-strapped Hong Kong, this is a particularly formidable challenge. Ip found the perfect solution at AsiaWorld-Expo which is readily accessible by MTR and other modes of transport. "You are right next to the MTR terminus here," he remarked.



Ip is especially impressed with the marshalling area: "It is spacious enough for us to create the vibe we have in mind for the carnival." Moreover, the close juxtaposition of indoor and outdoor facilities is a definite advantage in terms of flexibility, like the ready availability of the varied F&B services. "It is these conveniences and other small touches that add to visitors' overall enjoyment," Ip added.

Ip said that, ideally, they needed a year to plan such a mega event to perfection, but unfortunately, time was not on their side. But because much of the event infrastructure was already in place, and there was ready support from the professional team at AsiaWorld-Expo, they were able to pull it off in a matter of months. "Throughout the pre-function stage, the close liaison resulted in a very smooth execution of the multifarious jobs, culminating in a very successful event," Ip concluded.


